MULTI FACETED RISK PARAMETER EVALUATION

Various risk parameters were rated by the users on a licker scale of 1 to 5 for 1 being the lowest on risk and 5 being highest on risk. Based on the survey conducted below is the weighted risk value associated with various risk parameters of the study. Individual risk parameter weightage was calculated using following formula:

1. Performance Risk: More than 56 % respondents rated performance risk on the higher side.




Figure 1: Performance Risk

2. Financial Risk: more than 57% respondents rated financial risk on higher side.




Figure 2: Financial Risk

3. $\underline{\text{Time Risk:}}$ 53% respondents rated time risk moderate to high, while 17 % rated it to be highest.




Figure 3: Time Risk

4. <u>Psychological Risk</u>: 49 % respondents rated psychological risk on the lower side and another 18 % rated it as moderate risk.




Figure 4: Psychological Risk




Figure 5: Social & Cultural Risk




Figure 6: Privacy & Information Security Risk




Figure 7: Physical Risk




Figure 9: Policy/Law & Order Risk




Figure 11: Opportunism Risk




Figure 12: Overall Risk
